Today the legacy is now helping and improving the lives of young adults from all over the South West and further. Currently we have 33 residents living onsite receiving 24-hour care and support alongside 4-day placements. Many of our young adults have life limiting conditions and will spend the majority of the rest of their lives in our care and living on the Ivybridge site. Notwithstanding their disabilities, Dame Hannahs enables the people we support to live as independently as possible and supports them to participate in everyday life, including daily living skills and activities. We also provide a large number of social, therapeutic and sport sessions.
