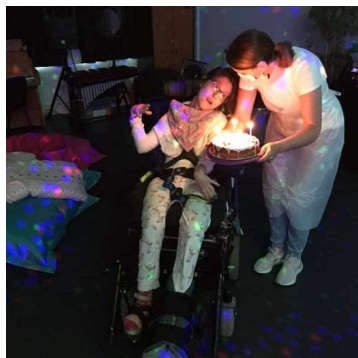


## Dame Hannahs News – July 2021
