

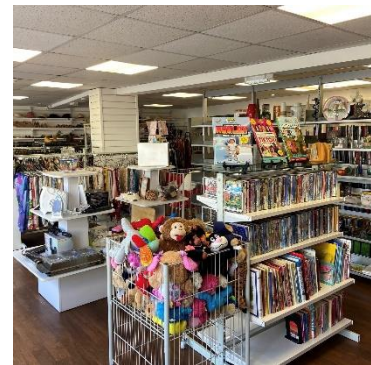

The Mews have been busy with various outings to celebrate birthdays. The young adults and staff went bowling recently and had a very successful time.



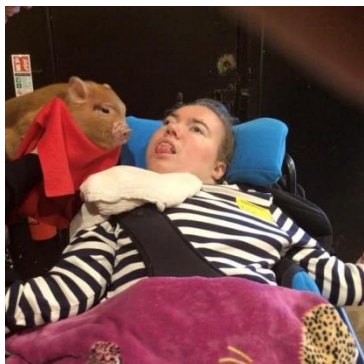
Sunny Walks
