We are so proud that her legacy lives on all these years later and we look forward to supporting and enriching the lives of our inspirational young people for many more years to come.

We are lucky to have 130 volunteers, ranging in age from 15 to 95 years old, working in our eight charity shops in lvybridge, Plymouth, Saltash and Newton Abbot. Between them the volunteers give over 1000 hours a week and over the last year the shops have raised £506,587.


Calling all Runners
